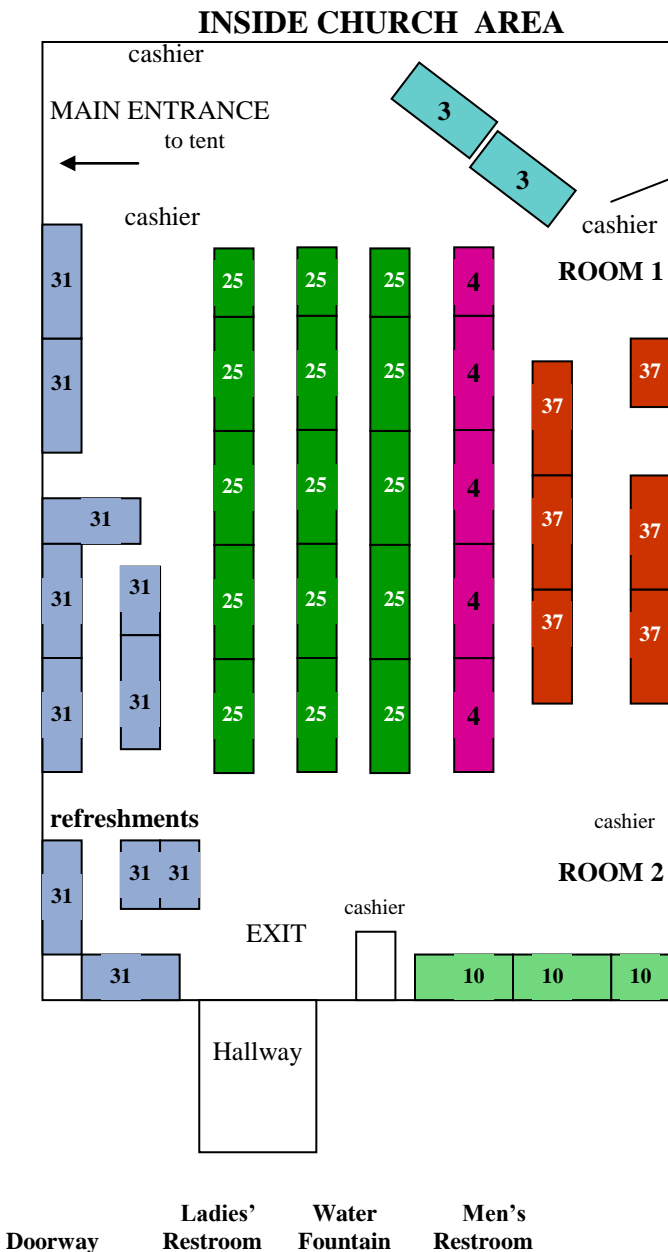

Approximate Floor plan of the Sale Site

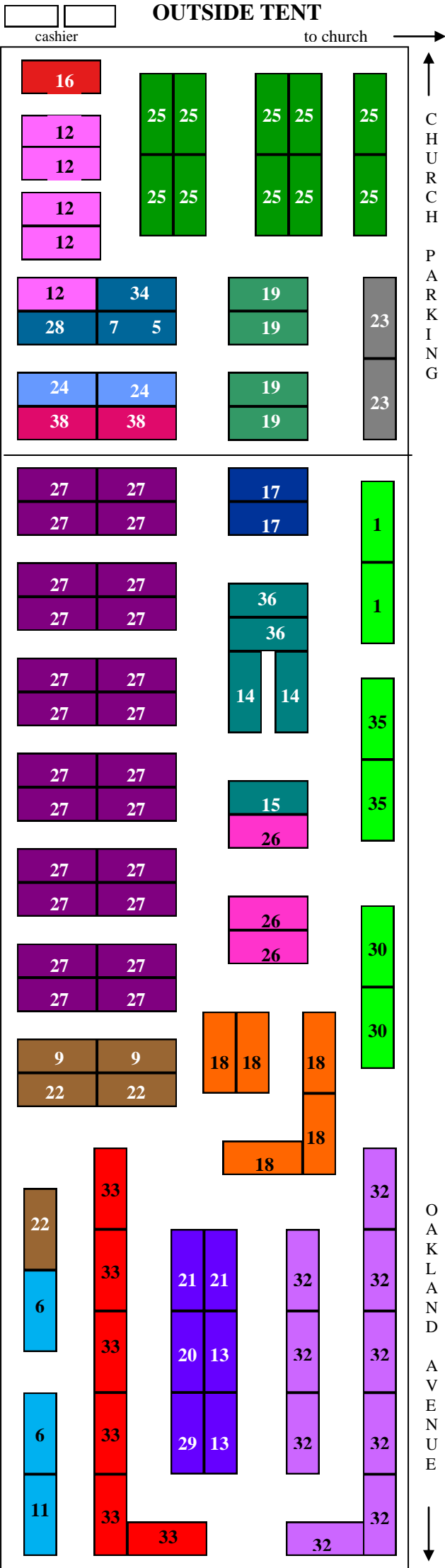
